GIOVANNIMARIA's words for MOTHER MARY

"Let's pray a Hail Mary for this mother and her baby"
From the age of four, he would point out pregnant women from his buggy, asking those around him to say a Hail Mary for this new mother and child.

"I am servant of Mother Mary"

he declared proudly when observing his mother pray for guidance from the Virgin Mary at St. Catherine of Siena Church in New York.

"Mum, Mother Mary is calling you!"

Giovannimaria told his mother one early morning, at dawn, soon after the family had learnt of his third relapse. He repeated it twice, reminding Cinzia of her calling and her mission.

"Mother Mary is here. Now she is covering the whole floor with her cloak." he told his mother while recovered in the hospital on the vigil night of Mother's Day 2013.

"Mary is watching us, and she's in the sky (heaven) so you can see her too!" he told his mother during his last hospital stays in May 2013. He informed his mother that the Virgin Mary was present and told him that he would soon go with Her. He died less than a month later.

Gio loved to pray the Rosary and made sure everyone prayed it every day. He was always eager to sing his favorite prayer: the *Salve Regina* in Latin. A funny note: he always sang *plentes* instead of *flentes*. When his mother would correct him, he smiled and shrugged. He preferred *plentes* (*plenty in English*).

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES

Giovannimaria Rainaldi was born in Rome on March 31 2006, at the Clinica della Santa Famiglia and was baptized on May 24 of the same year. At 18 months old, an abdominal ultrasound revealed the presence of a large mass that turned out to be a GanglioNeuroblastoma, a very aggressive pediatric tumor with a generally poor prognosis, diagnosed at the Pediatric Clinic of the Sapienza Polyclinic. On December 19, 2007, after two cycles of chemotherapy, he underwent his first very delicate surgical operation in New York, at the Memorial Sloane Kettering Cancer Center (MSKCC), from which he emerged with an excellent prognosis, to the point of being able to return to live in Italy for all of 2008 and part of 2009. But then the disease started again, more aggressive than before. Despite a life deeply marked by suffering (he underwent 2 cycles of radiotherapy, 21 cycles of chemotherapy, 4 highrisk surgical operations, lasting about 10 hours each), he never lost his smile, his ability to fight ("never give up" - he told his mother) and to comfort his family, because his was a "beautiful life", because Jesus had given it to him. His was a luminous testimony, full of signs of the presence of the Holy Spirit, which all those who met him noticed. Having strongly requested and desired First Communion, he received it for the first time on 13 June 2012 (Feast of St. Anthony of Padua) and from that day on, he will receive it every day. On 30 May 2013, Corpus Christi Feast, Gio, who was according to his own words "servant of Mary" and "the lamb of Jesus", was born into Heaven, leaving in many hearts an indelible trace of communion with the Lord.

THEY SAY ABOUT GIO

...Now, I don't know and I don't even want to know how things went 'scientifically', because the real help that I continued to receive from GIO is something else, that is to say having understood that true well-being, true salvation, consists in orienting our daily actions towards love for others, and fighting against our fragilities and the many distractions, in short, in letting the Lord enter into us. I don't know where this journey of Faith will take me, which often appears as a narrow and steep path, but at every important crossroads I'm happy to think that GIO is nearby ready to lend me his little hand, and that it's only up to me to read the heart and choose the direction.
